

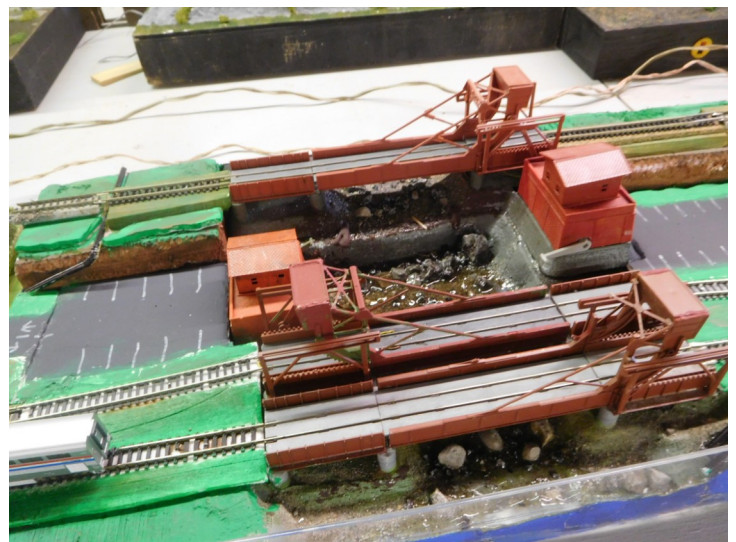

At the ceremony celebrating the completion of the transcontinental railroad, Central Pacific Railroad president Leland Stanford arrived aboard a steam-powered locomotive called Jupiter. This made Jupiter the first passenger train to travel from west to east on the transcontinental railroad. It was met in Promontory by Union Pacific locomotive No. 119.
