Leland Stantord, an industrialist and politician who also founded Stanford University, was the president of the Central Pacific Railroad Company when the transcontinental railroad was finished in 1869. As such, Stanford presided over the ceremony commemorating the completion of the railroad, and signaled the end of the construction process by tapping the golden "last spike" into the ground.
